BOOKING OF JULY MASS SLOTS - PHASE 3 HEIGHTENED ALERT (P3 HA)

With effect from **July 2021**, Church of the Holy Cross will increase the capacity of three weekend Masses to 250 pax.

If you are **fully vaccinated** (completed 14 days after second dose of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine) **OR** have taken ART or PCR Pre-Event Testing (PET) by an approved test provider with results valid for 24 hours till the end of Mass, you may book these Mass slots: Saturday 4pm, Sunday 7.30am or 9.30am.

If you are **not fully vaccinated** or did not take PET, you may book these Mass slots: Saturday 6pm (Mandarin), Sunday 11.30am or 5pm.

All weekday Masses are capped at 50 pax. Each person can book up to **5 weekday Masses** per weekly booking session.

Booking will open on **Tuesday, 29 June at 3pm.**

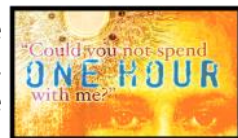

PRIMARY ONE REGISTRATION FOR CATHOLIC SCHOOLS (2B)

Calling all Catholic parents whose children are ready for Primary One Registration Phase 2B on 26 July and 27 July 2021.



Priority for registration under Phase 2B is for a child of a baptised Catholic parent.

Requirements:

One parent has to submit the baptism certificate as evidence of Church membership.

If the Baptism Certificate is not in English, it is mandatory to have it translated into English and certified by a parish priest in Singapore or a notary public.
