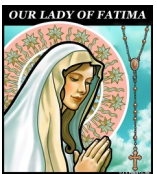

Cardinal William Goh has revoked the decree issued on 15 Feb 2020 when the obligatory Sunday Mass attendance was dispensed with. He now instructs that participation in the Sunday Eucharist or the anticipatory Mass on Saturday is once again a required obligation. It will officially be reinstated on Easter Sunday, 9 April 2023.
