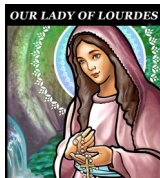

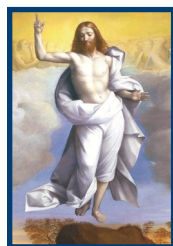

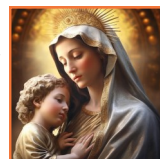
We have invited 2 Sisters and 2 Priests to come and share their vocation stories with us.
